PROGRAM OVERVIEW: PJA Afterschool Programs strive to provide culturally responsive community environments where children feel safe and supported as they socialize, explore, learn and play. Our programs are choice-based with an emphasis on life skills and service learning. Students are offered the opportunity to participate in teacher-led enrichment activities and large group active games each day. PJA Afterschool programs serve approximately 300 families across 5 programs in the Portland metro. Individual program attendance ranges from 15 children to 70 per day. We staff for a 1:10 ratio. JOB SUMMARY: The Afterschool Teacher is responsible for the direct care and supervision of youth in PJA before and afterschool programs. This position supports an atmosphere and an environment conducive to the intellectual, social and emotional development of school-age students in an afterschool setting.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES:

- Plan and implement developmentally appropriate curriculum in accordance with PJA-Afterschool Department policy.
- Monitor youth and afterschool spaces to ensure safe participation. Ensure that program and behavior management expectations are met and maintained.
- Work collaboratively and communicate courteously and effectively with colleagues, parents, students and the public.

- Understand and adhere to state licensing policies and standards.
- Obtain 18 clock hours of professional development through attendance at workshops, seminars, trainings and conferences.

TEACHER QUALIFICATIONS:

- Minimum 18 years of age
- Bachelor's degree or Master's degree from four-year college or university; or at least 1 year experience working with elementary school age children; or a combination of experience and qualifying education; or documentation of a step 8 in the Oregon Registry
- Ability to successfully enroll in the Oregon Central Background Registry and obtain Introduction to Child Care Health and Safety certification prior to working directly with children
- Ability to obtain and/or maintain the following with the first 30 days of employment:, Recognizing and Reporting Child Abuse and Neglect and Food Handler certification
- Ability to obtain and/or maintain the following with the first 60 days of employment: Child and Adult First Aid/CPR certification
- Ability to supervise groups of children, ages 5-12
- Ability to work with passion, energy and enthusiasm
- Ability to communicate clearly and positively with both children and adults
- Ability to work under pressure in noisy and often chaotic environments while maintaining empathy and patience
